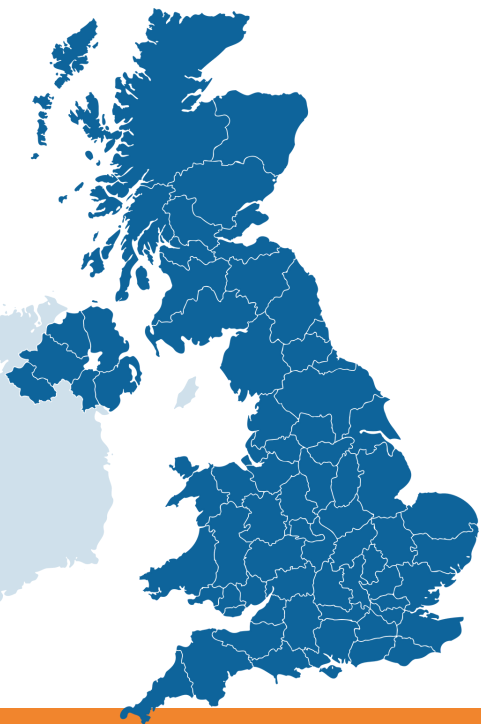


**Together we can find
