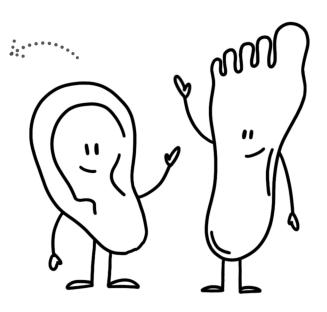


## There are many parts
